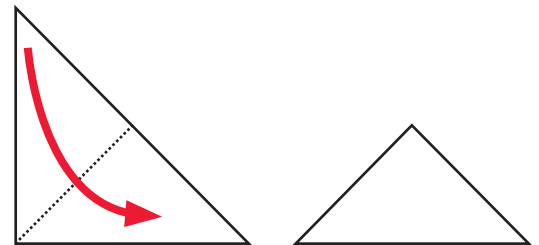
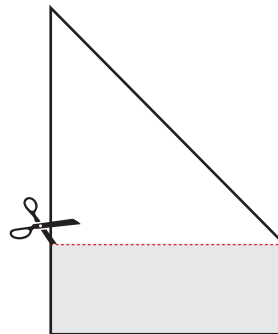
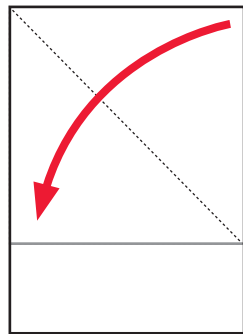
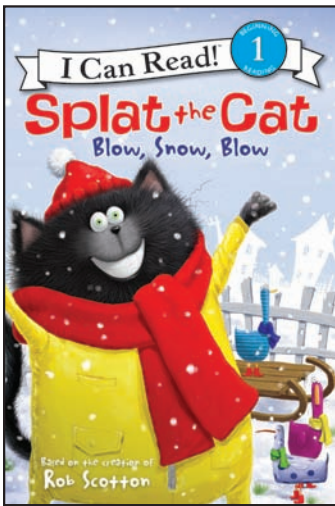


# Splat the Cat! Snowflake!

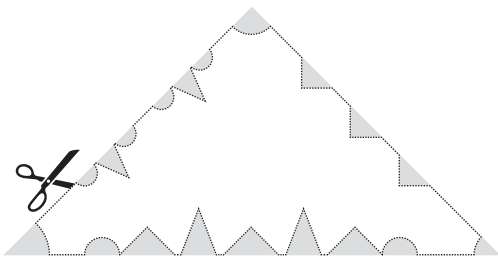
Remember—always ask permission from an adult before using scissors.

Supplies: Paper • Scissors

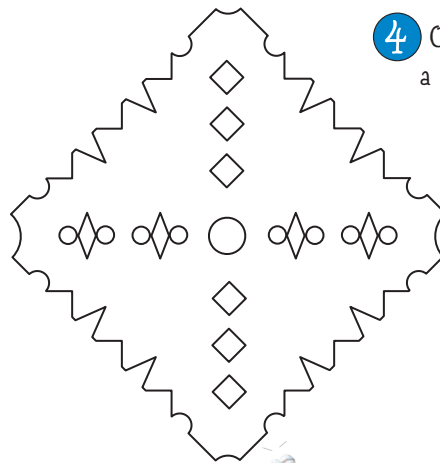


**1** Fold your piece of paper in half so it makes a triangle. If you have excess paper on one side, use scissors to cut it off.

**2** Fold the paper in half again so it makes a smaller triangle.

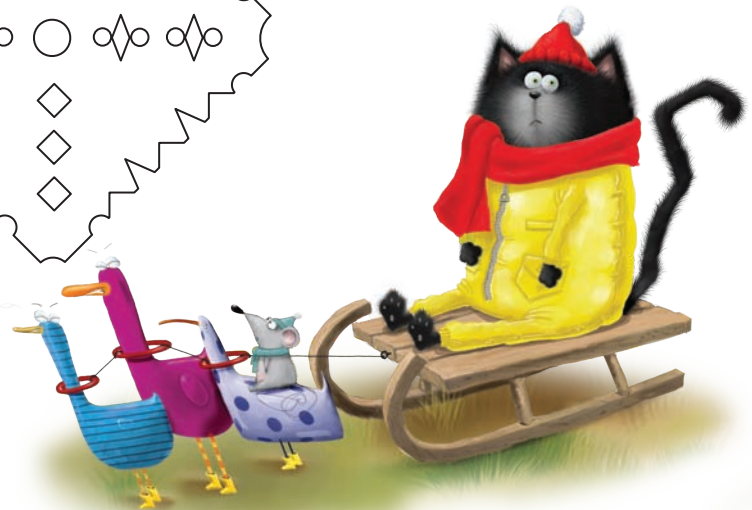


**3** Use the scissors to cut sections out of the triangle along all sides. Remember to leave part of the folded edges together!



**4** Open up your paper, and you will have a unique snowflake. Try hanging it on a window for all to see!

If you are looking for more ways to create a snowflake, try using different colored construction paper. You can also cover the snowflake with glitter to make it sparkly!
