


THE BEGINNING TEVERYTHING BY ROBYN SCHNEIDER

ABOUT THE BOOK

- 2. Do you agree with Ezra's theory that everyone has a tragedy waiting for them?
- 3. Why do Ezra and his friends drift apart? Have you ever experienced a similar situation with your friends?
- 4. If you were Ezra, would you have handled the aftermath of the accident any differently? How so?
- 5. How is your high school similar to Eastwood? How is it different?
- 6. Why do you think Ezra finds himself drawn to Cassidy? Do you think that Cassidy is Ezra's everything or just the beginning?

- 7. How does the friendship between Toby and Ezra change throughout the story?
- 8. What do you think of Ezra's two different circles of friends? Which group is better for Ezra? How so?
- 9. Do you think that Cassidy's parents put too much pressure on their children? Why or why not?
- 10. Did you suspect Cassidy's secret at any point in the story? How does her secret change her relationship with Ezra?
- 11. Do you agree with Cassidy's decisions at the end of the novel? Why or why not?
